## What happens next?

The Council will consider your comments and decide whether to take forward the scheme, and what control hours to use. Further information will be provided at the web address given above in due course. If there is sufficient community support, a detailed design will be prepared and the Council would commence the legal process (including further consultation) to take the scheme forward.

## Supplementary proposals:

Cycle hangars or motorcycle bays may be introduced where space allows. This will ensure that the scheme helps those who travel by cycle or motorcycle as well as by car. Secure bike storage is crucial in streets where homes lack garages.



Making it easier for residents to own cycles and motorcycles, and to use them instead of cars for some trips, helps reduce local congestion and emissions. The Department for Transport has estimated that 3% of UK homes own at least one motorcycle, equating to around 4 motorcycles across the proposed zone. Providing for greater future ownership would be logical as pressure on road space in London continues to increase.

# Osborne Road and Windsor Road Controlled Parking Zone Consultation

In response to requests from residents, this leaflet sets out the Council's proposals for a Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) in Osborne Road and Windsor Road.

The aim is to provide fairer access to on-street parking space in the area. The back page gives instructions on how to respond.



## Why is this needed?

Residents, shoppers, local businesses and others currently compete for limited on-street parking. Permit controls would offer better balance to local parking arrangements and give priority to residents of Osborne Road and Windsor Road.

## How will it help?

A CPZ is an area where residents are given parking priority over other drivers through a permit system. Two options are being considered:

**Option A** proposes controls for an hour or two during the day. During this period, only those with a permit would be able to park in the zone. This would deter long-stay parking by commuters, but anyone would be free to park in the zone at all other times. As indicated in the table opposite, a permit for this type of zone is half the cost of one for a zone that operates all day.


**Option B** controls parking across the day but comes with higher permit prices to account for the extended enforcement activity. This option should prove effective at also deterring all-day parking by commuters, shop workers and people visiting the nearby shops and services.

The existing pay and display parking bays close to Green Lanes would be retained with both options.
